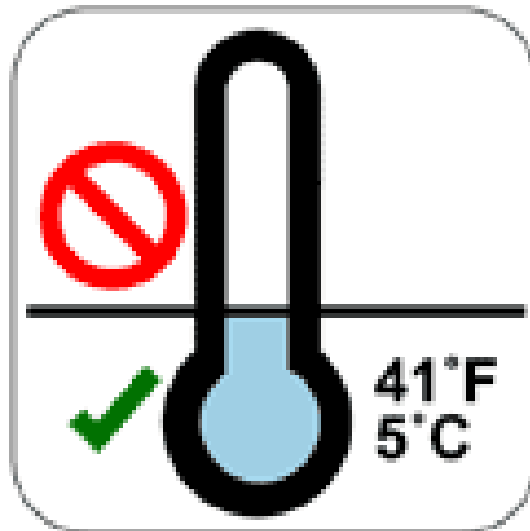


Inspection Report Item 12: Food Received at Proper Temperatures

FDA Food Code References: 3-202.11



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Receiving Temperatures

Generally, all cold temperature control for safety (TCS Foods) must be received at 41°F or below. Some exceptions are:

- Shell eggs must be received at 45°F or lower.
- Shellfish and shellstock must be received at 45°F or lower.
- Frozen foods must be received frozen.
